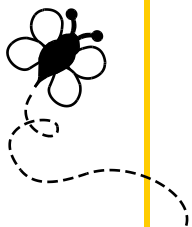

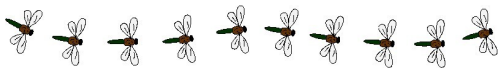

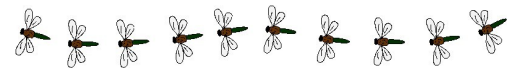

Summer Guidelines and Procedures



Junior Camp and Kindergarten Camp Enrollment Guidelines

- ★ Junior Camp and Kindergarten Camp is held in two week sessions. Classes will not be held Monday, July 4th. Children may enroll for one or more sessions.
- ★ The first session your child attends must be pre-paid in full and must accompany your child's enrollment form. You will be billed for subsequent sessions. Tuition is non-refundable.
- ★ Camp tuition includes lunch.
- ★ New students must have a complete file to attend camp. If your child is a current student, these forms should already be on file. Please see the list of forms below. They may be downloaded from www.kensingtonschool.com.
- ★ Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. Children may only enroll for a full session. Full tuition is due regardless of attendance. Any changes to a child's schedule must be made 30 days in advance.

Every Child's File Requirements

These forms must be reviewed before your child's first day and can be found at www.kensingtonschool.com:

- ★ Enrollment Form, completed and signed by a parent
- ★ Medical Form, completed and signed by a physician and also signed by a parent
- ★ Consent Form, completed and signed by a parent
- ★ Authorization for Emergency Medical Care
- ★ Discipline Policy Form
- ★ Verification of Receipt for the Summary of DCFS Licensing Standards
- ★ Copy of child's birth certificate
- ★ Getting to Know You Form
- ★ Contingency Pick Up Form
- ★ Late Pick-Up Policy Statement

Summer Camp Procedures

- ★ Each day your child should bring the following items:
 - Waterproof tote bag or backpack with the child's name on the outside of the bag.
 - A complete change of clothes.
 - Rubber soled shoes or aqua shoes (these are highly recommended).
 - Please do not send your child in open toe sandals. They are not safe for climbing or running.
- ★ Please see that all of your child's belongings are CLEARLY LABELED with your child's first initial and last name.
- ★ PLEASE APPLY SUNSCREEN TO YOUR CHILD EVERYDAY BEFORE COMING TO CAMP!
- ★ Sprinkler Water Day Apparel: (A note from your child's school will give you water day dates!)
 - Each camper should come to camp in a swimsuit worn under his or her play clothes.
 - Girls should wear a two-piece suit if possible so bathroom needs can be easily managed.
 - Bring a large towel (labeled) in his or her waterproof bag.
 - Bring a complete change of clothes.
