KENSINGTON SENIOR CAMP 2011 ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES

An Active Summer Camp for 6-10 year-olds

Six year-olds have a choice of two camps, Senior Camp or our new “Wings” camp.
(Please see separate brochure for Kensington Camps for 2-6 year-olds.)

To enroll, please complete the attached enrollment form
and return with a \$25 non-refundable deposit per week.

Upon enrollment, you will receive forms that must be completed before camp.

1. You may enroll your child by the week with varying days each week. Any changes to a child’s schedule must be made 30 days in advance.
2. Enrollment forms must be returned with a \$25 per week non-refundable deposit to reserve your child’s space for that week. These deposits are applicable to each week’s tuition and are non-refundable.
3. You will be billed \$10/day for each scheduled swimming and field trip day. Depending upon each camp’s schedule, there will be 2 or 3 of these days each week. Full tuition for these days is due regardless of attendance.
4. Full tuition is due the first day of the camp each month for all weeks enrolled in that month. **TUITION DUE DATES:** June 13, July 5, August 1
5. A late fee of \$20 is charged if payment is not received by the first Thursday of the month.
6. Full tuition is due regardless of attendance. Refunds are not made for absences. Parents are responsible for full camp payment for each week enrolled. Enrollment is on a first come, first served basis.
7. To meet the guidelines set by the Department of Children and Family Services, it is required that forms be completed, returned, and reviewed before the first day of camp.

Must be on file if previously enrolled or completed if new to Kensington -
